## Part 4 Educating the players and parents

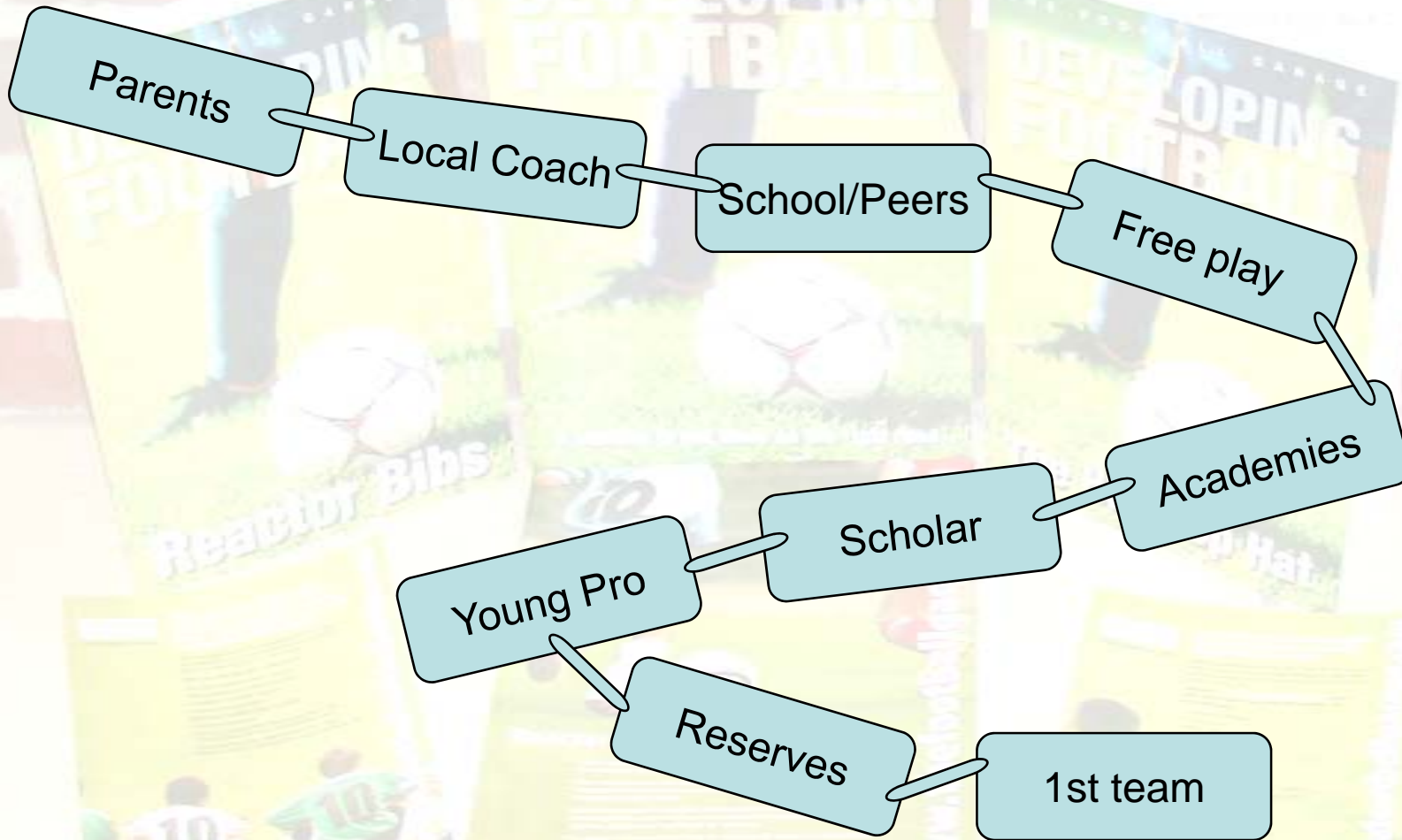
- Empowering the parents in order to increase the pool of quality players at our disposal
